ABSTRACT TITLE:

Descriptive title; maximum 20 words.

AUTHORS:

Include all authors (first name and surname) and their primary affiliation as appropriate of the work conducted. Indicate the presenting author. Omit degrees and titles.

SUBMISSION CATEGORY:

Indicate the appropriate scientific category for your abstract (please see the list of scientific categories above)

FORMAT FOR AN ABSTRACT:

Abstract brings original research findings, case studies, completed projects and theoretical analyses as well as analyses issues and solutions to problems in clinical practice, community engagement, education, health promotion and policy. Abstracts should be rigorous and demonstrate a novel contribution to basic knowledge and practice.

Abstracts must be structured as follows:

- **Background:** indicate the purpose and objective of the research, the hypothesis tested, or a description of the problem being analysed or evaluated.
- **Methods:** describe the study period, setting and location, study design and methodology, study population, data collection and methods of analysis used.
- **Results:** present findings as clearly and in as much detail as possible; must include data and/or substantial information about results.
- **Conclusion:** explain the significance of the study's findings for the STI field and/or future implications of the results.
